If you earned an 80% you can raise your grade to a 90% If you earned an 70% you can raise your grade to a 85% If you earned an 60% you can raise your grade to a 80% If you earned an 50% you can raise your grade to a 75% If you earned an 40% you can raise your grade to a 70%
[] Do the Exam Correction Problems and Self Reflection. Once you have the Exam Correction Problems done, email Joanna your attempt. She will email you solutions and you should correct your problems (in another color). If you got some wrong say why. (You can earn one point per problem).
